Guidelines for SCC Summer Bursary Program

- The School Community Council (SCC) has allocated \$1000 to continue its summer bursary program to help two or more students who are currently in grades 9, 10, 11 to attend summer programs in the arts, athletics, academics, leadership, etc. The program doesn't have to be connected to something the student does at Sheldon.
- The bursary covers only registration fees, to a maximum of \$500 for an individual student. Other expenses, such as, transportation, accommodation and food are the responsibility of the student and his/her family. (In the case of a residential camp, accommodation might be included in the registration fee.)
- Since the goal of the SCC is to help students take advantage of new opportunities, student can only apply for assistance to attend a program that he/she has never attended.
- In order to provide opportunities to as many students as possible, a student can receive SCC assistance for summer programs only once.
- Criteria to be considered in choosing recipients include dedication the student has shown in the program area and potential benefit to the student and community. Financial need may be considered.
- Recipients of the SCC Summer Program Bursary are expected to provide a brief description of their experience to the SCC. This report can be done in person at the September SCC meeting or by submitting a letter, photo essay, video, etc.
